**Grant Requirements and Face Mask Construction Grant Application Final Report Information**

- If selected, this grant will provide 1) Up to \$200 upon award of grant and 2) \$50 reimbursement for overages, upon receipt of constructed masks and submittal of a Face Mask Construction Grant Application Final Report (required).
- Checks will be picked up at San Diego - Imperial Council Service Center; 1207 Upas Street; San Diego, CA 92103, if quarantine restrictions are lifted. Otherwise, alternate arrangements will be made, as necessary.
- Delivery of face masks will be required within 45 days of grant acceptance. Your unit will have 45 days to gather materials and sewing machines, train scouts, sew masks and deliver to the SDIC Service Center, if quarantine restrictions are lifted. Otherwise, alternate arrangements will be made, as necessary.
- Grant monies may only be spent on fabric, elastic, ties, thread and Plastic Storage bags. Original receipts must be attached to the Face Mask Construction Grant Application Final Report.
- Units may spend / allocate more than the \$250 grant capital. Additional funding above the \$250 would be from unit funding and/or Scout supervised fundraising which is appreciated by SDIC and ESAA. Additional funding should be reported on the Face Mask Construction Grant Application Final Report.
- Scouts, Units, Scout leaders, parents and others supporting Scouts selected for this grant program may be interviewed, photographed and publicized for promotional purposes with the SDIC social media, webpage and digital communications. The SDIC may coordinate promotion with the local media, county healthcare agencies and/or other agencies authorized by the SDIC. The SDIC will assure all Youth Protective Training guidelines (YPT) are followed. The ESAA and SDIC want to positively promote the role of Scouts, Scout leaders, parents and others supporting Scouting in this important, public health initiative.
