

## ESAA/NESA Committee Meeting on April 2, 2020

### Action Notes:

- **Notes approved** from April, 2020.
- **I Love a Clean San Diego:** All discussed the organizations request to consider the new clean-up date of June 20<sup>th</sup>. All agreed the date would be difficult due to the pandemic and calendar conflict concerns. Dan said he would contact the organization and pass the message.
- **Eagle Dinner:** All discussed the wait and see nature of the Eagle dinner scheduled for June 16, 2020. As the pandemic progresses and event viability for this date is evaluated it will be communicated to all. Key support tasks provided by ESAA/NESA were discussed: 1) Help recruiting sponsors 2) Centerpiece placement 2) help as the even committee needs.
- **Gathering of Eagles:** The idea of an expanded gathering of eagles was discussed. The concept included engaging key community leaders that are Eagle Scouts to increase attendance, engage a noteworthy speaker and ultimately help with ESAA/NESA projects supporting Scouting. Sean is in the process of scheduling videoconference meetings (due to the pandemic) to ask for this support. Sean, Dan and Matthew will work together closely as this comes together.
- **Scouting Good-Turn:** The Eagle Scout Alumni Association (ESAA) of the San Diego-Imperial Council supports the production of breathing masks to promote public health in light of the COVID-19 Pandemic. The ESAA supports production via:
  - Production by individual Scouts and Scout troops
  - Production by Cub Scouts and Cub Scout Packs
  - Production by Scouts seeking to promote and provide community serviceThe ESAA will support all efforts by the Scouting community through financial assistance from individual ESAA members and from ESAA resources. Through ESAA Board members connected to the public health sectors - information will be provided on production of breathing masks to meet sanitary regulations.
